

## Instructions for Antarctica Station (6)

Each team member gets a copy of the map of Antarctica from the folder in the kiosk. Then give each person a textbook and go and get the emergency map pencil box from your Antarctica shelf.

**Step 1** - Give each member a textbook and turn to p. RA30. You may also use the atlases in the bookcase by your station (see page 104.)

**Step 2** - TODAL

- Create a **title** for your map.
- **Orient** your map with a compass rose pointing in the correct direction.
- Create a **date** for your map.
- Write your first and last **name** on the map (you are the author.)
- Create a legend with the following symbols:

Mountains

Pole

Ice Shelf

**Step 3** - Using a black ink pen draw in and label the following: Transantarctic Mountains, Amery Ice Shelf, Ross Ice Shelf, Ronne Ice Shelf, South Pole. USE THE SYMBOLS FROM THE LEGEND. Water: Indian Ocean, Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Ross Sea Weddell Sea.

**Step 4** - Color as you see fit. You can use color to highlight physical features. What is important is that the entire map is covered with color. Don't leave any white space. Color all water **blue** (this includes rivers).

**Step 5** - Glue the map to p. **25** of your interactive notebook.
