

Instructions for Station 3

Station Type: Challenge - Map Interpretation

North America Challenge

You will be working as a group examining the placards at your station and answering ten questions about North American geography. The challenge is to figure out which of the placards answer the question and to use them to answer all 10 questions before the period runs out.

Step 1 - In the folders you will find five placards with five types of maps of the United States and Canada. Materials Manager pass one of each type to each person on the team.

Step 2 - Pass out two handouts called "Canada and the United States":

The handout with questions # 1-6 is glued to **page 42**.

The handout with questions # 7-10 is glued to **page 43**.

Step 3 - Place your answers in the boxes with the questions.

Step 4 - Create definitions from the context of the questions from the words listed after question 10. This is listed as question # 11. (At the bottom of Part 2)

Step 5 - When you are done with the questions, place the placards back into their correct folder. Materials Managers will confirm that all are sticking up out of the folders to be counted.
