

Narrative Essay: “If You Really Knew Me...”

Paragraph 1: Develop an exciting lead or hook, and use it to begin a completely fictional description of yourself.

- Person- should be you, but an alter ego version
- Place- pick an unusual place for your character to be
- Things around you- be sure to describe with adjectives

The last sentence of this paragraph should begin with a transition that shows contrast as you let the reader know this isn't really you.

Paragraphs 2-4: Show the REAL you by elaborating on the three main types of information below. (One for each paragraph):

- Your wants and desires
- Your fears
- Unusual insights into your personality
